colour blocking

nail care 101

trim, file, buff, repeat

Preparation is key. Trimming, filing and buffing your nails is extremely important if you want your nails to look spot on.

care for your cuticles

When it comes to nail care, looking after your cuticles is a must. To help you get the results you want, you could use a specially designed cuticle peel. These products help to smooth the skin around your nail, making it easier to push the cuticle back and ensuring a beautifully finished manicure.

start with a base coat, seal with a top coat

Before you paint your digits, you should always start with a base layer of clear varnish. This will protect your nails from becoming stained by your polish, as well as creating an even surface for applying colour. It will also help ensure your chosen shade looks more saturated and opaque.

Once you're done applying your colour, you should seal it with a

top coat. Like the base coat, this should be a clear varnish. This last step will help to add a subtle gloss finish to your nails.

give it a rest

Even if you're utterly obsessed with painting your digits, it's important to give them a break. Between applying polish and practising your nail art techniques, your fingernails can become dry, brittle and discoloured, so in order to keep them looking and feeling their best, it's crucial that you let them rest and repair from time to time.
